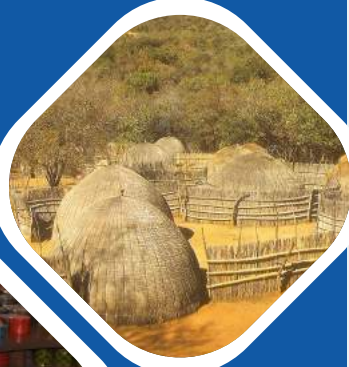

Full papers for accepted abstracts must not exceed 4500 words.

### Authors must use:

- font type: Times New Roman;
- font size: 12 and 1.5 spacing.

The theme being addressed should be clearly stated.

- 30 April 2024 for PowerPoint presentations.
