Instructions:

- 1. There are three (3) projects listed below. Choose one (1) project.
- **2.** Follow the technological design process to do the write up and when making the chosen product.

(a) Weave a Basket.

- (i) Use any suitable material in your environment (plastics, grasses or any other materials).
- (ii) Choose a weaving style.
- (iii) The size of the basket should be 30cm x 30cm x 20cm
- (iv) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (v) Cost and prize the product.
- (vi) Make a poster to advertise the product.

(b) Carve a Sugar Bowl.

- (i) Choose any available and appropriate material for carving.
- (ii) Select a suitable carving technique for styling and shaping the product.
- (iii) The bowl should not be less than 5cm x 10cm x 15 cm.
- (iv) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (v) Cost and prize the product.
- (vi) Make a poster to advertise the product.

(c) Make a Doll using recycled materials.

- (i) Choose the suitable material for making the doll.
- (ii) Select appropriate style and shape when making the product.
- (iii) The three dimensional doll or toy should not be less than 20 cm in height.
- (iv) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (v) Cost and prize the product.
- (vi) Make a poster to advertise the product.
