Your letter must include:


- What you think causes the situation

Your letter should be about 150 - 200 words long.



Exercise 2


Home learning using radios and television is becoming popular these days. However, some people feel it cannot replace classroom teaching. Below are some comments by members of the public who were interviewed on this matter.




Great idea! It will lower the education expenses.
