- Describe how you plan to mend your strained friendship.


Your letter should be 150-200 words long. Do not write the address.

You will receive up to 8 marks for the content of your letter and up to 7 marks for the style and accuracy of your language.


Exercise 2

The National Youth Organisation is supporting a Bill of Rights for teenagers in your country.


Below are some comments by different stakeholders concerning the bill:




'That's a good move since young people need to be empowered.'
