Continuous Writing

General Comments:

The total number of candidates who sat for this component in 2024 were 17422. Paper 1 is continuous writing where candidates were assessed on their ability to express ideas, facts, and opinions clearly and effectively using a range of appropriate vocabulary. They have to handle spelling, punctuation and grammar accurately, and show creativity in their writing.

The paper consists of two (2) sections and is marked out of 50 marks. Section A is a free composition worth 30 marks, and Section B is a situational composition worth 20 marks. Section A has three (3) questions of different composition types and the candidates were expected to choose one (1) question whilst, Section B is a compulsory question.

Candidates performed better in Section A than they did in Section B. It must be noted that for Section B, the format of the situational composition is key in the marking of the content. So, the candidates failed to use the correct format for this situational composition type which was a diary.

Comments on Specific Questions

Sicephu A

Umbuto 1

Topic: Bhala indzaba lechazako icale ngalamagama latsi, "Juba ngalapho...!"

This was a descriptive composition where candidates were expected to describe a scene where a person or an animal (most likely cows) was being chased/driven (in the case of cows) by either a person or a crowd. The candidates were given a statement and were instructed to begin the composition (Introduction) as directed. To score marks effectively/correct response, the candidate was expected to vividly describe a scene using descriptive register to create a mental picture of the incident in the reader. Candidates who were not able to score effectively failed to describe a scene but instead they narrated stories which were irrelevant to the question. There were candidates who also failed to begin the composition with the words, "Juba Ngalapho...!"

It can also be noted that candidates are still in the habit of writing far-fetched and exaggerated stories which are hard to believe. There were a few cases of plagiarism where candidates wrote on events portrayed in the prescribed Form 5 drama text. This question was poorly performed.

Umbuto 2

Topic: Imfundvo yamahhala ayichubekele nasemabangeni laphakeme etikolweni. Bhala indzabamphikiswano ngalesihloko.

This question was an argumentative composition where candidates were expected to argue for or against the introduction of Free Secondary Education. This was a very popular question and most candidates who attempted this question were able to score effective marks. The candidates were expected to:

- Introduce the topic
- Take a stand in the introduction
- Argue for and support their stand convincingly by using examples, statistics and rhetorical questions
- State the views of the opposition to create a balanced argument by using cohesive devices like "Ngakulolunye luhlangotsi", "Labanye batsi", "Labangahambisani nalombono batsi..."
- Conclude by emphasizing their stand without adding a new argument/point

Candidates who failed to write a balanced argument were not effectively scored but were scored on average. Candidates were also expected to write 300-400 words but some candidates failed to meet the desired composition length, therefore scoring average marks. Not meeting the required length was a result of arguing only for one side.

There were candidates who deviated from the question by arguing for the introduction of Free University Education instead of Free Secondary School Education – "...emabangeni laphakeme..." was mistaken for university instead of secondary/high school by the candidates. It is commendable that there were few cases of candidates who failed to write a balanced argumentative composition as is the requirement of this composition type. This question, therefore, was well done.

Umbuto 3

Topic: Titselo netibhidvo kudliwa kakhulu kulamalanga. Bhala indzaba lenikka lwati ngebumcoka betibhidvo netitselo.

This was an informative composition where candidates which required candidates to write on the importance of fruits and vegetables. Candidates who scored effectively were able to write on the importance of fruits and vegetables in human health, the economy and socially – *kutemphilo, kutemnotfo nekutenhlalakahle*. There were candidates who were not able to think out of the box – these only focused on the importance of fruits and vegetables on human health. Some candidates deviated from the question by describing fruits and vegetables, how they are grown and their maintenance which scored them extremely low marks.

There were candidates, however, who were able to effectively write on the importance of fruits and vegetables broadly covering health, economically and socially, scoring themselves high marks. This was the least popular question, however, candidates who attempted it scored effectively.

Sicephu B

Umbuto 4

Topic: Batali bakho bakwentele indumezulu yelidzili lekukuhalalisela ngekuphotfula ekolisho. Bhala idayari yelusuku uchaze konkhe lokwenteka ngalolusuku.

This is a situational composition and it is a compulsory question. The candidates were required to write a one-day diary on a spectacular party (*indumezulu yelidzili*) their parents threw/celebrated in their honour after graduating from college.

The diary had to have a topic and could have 3-5 paragraphs or more – each paragraph had to have a sub-heading/title of the time(s) each event happened on the day. For example:

Sihloko

I-dayari yelusuku yelidzili lekuphotfula ekolishi

Sihlokwana - indzima 1

Insimbi yesiphohlongo ekuseni kuya ensimbini yelishumi ekuseni

Bekuphitsitela ebaleni kumiswa emathende, bobabekati bapheka batfulula ngabogalaza ...

Sihlokwana – indzima 2

Insimbi yelishumi ekuseni kuya ensimbini yelishumi nakubili emini

Emathende lamhlophe bekagcwele aphuphuma, wawungafunga kutsi ngumshado wenkhosatana...

Candidates were expected to focus on the events of the party – where and when was the party; guests; programme director; speeches; dress code; activities like music and dancing; gifts and finally, they had to describe their feelings as they write as that is an important feature in a diary. This question was the worst performed in this examination mainly because of the following reasons:

- Some candidates failed to write using the required format for a diary they just related events without structuring it in paragraphs using clock times as sub-headings. It must be noted that candidates can either write clock times or adverbs of time, "ekuseni", "emini yasekuseni", "emini", "ntsambama".
- Some candidates wrote about their graduation ceremony at their college/university which was a total misinterpretation of the question
- Some candidates missed the point by focusing on, "...uchaze konkhe lokwenteka ngalolusuku" which resulted in them relating too much on what they did in the morning when they woke up; what they did in town during the day in preparation for the party and just at the end in only two sentences would they then try to squeeze in details about the party.

Most candidates failed to display a sense of purpose for the diary – the tone used was not that of a diary but it was for a narrative composition. Teachers are advised to teach all the different types of Situational Compositions focusing on the style, purpose and register.

Paper 6870/02

Reading and Directed Writing

Key Messages

- This component assesses candidates' comprehension skills, the ability to draw inferences, make sound interpretations, and knowledge of grammatical and linguistic formulations of the siSwati language.
- It is essential for candidates to be specific in their responses and demonstrate application skills in questions that require contextualization and operations of everyday life situations.
- Candidates must read carefully questions and identify key words so as to give specific answers.
- When attempting question 2(a), candidates should observe the required number of words (60-90) to present a concise summary with coherent points. They should avoid lifting words from the passage, but they should identify key points that are required by the question. Such a habit result in some candidates exceeding the expected number of words required by the question.
- Proof reading is another important element in this paper. Candidates who fail to do lose some marks.
- Question 2(b) requires candidates to demonstrate skillful use of language and creativity without losing focus of the task, and ultimately present pieces of work as directed by the question.
- In answering Section B questions, candidates must demonstrate grammatical and linguistic proficiency in the language.
- Candidates should always underline words that are answers in sentences.

General Comments

A total of 17422 candidates sat for this component in 2024, which showed a significant increase of 1186 candidates. The overall performance of the candidates was average though there were those who were far below the average because they did not understand the requirement of the questions. Only a few obtained maximum marks in question 1, 3 and 4. Some did not attempt questions 3 and 4. However, these were compensated by scoring higher marks in 2(a). There were a few candidates that performed well in all the questions.

Comments on Specific Questions

Sicephu A

Umbuto 1(a) – (f)

(a) Bhala kubili longehlukanisa ngako ingwe kuletinye tilwane letifana nayo.

Most candidates performed very well in this question. They gave physical features of the leopard that make it easy to identify it.

Expected responses:

- Bukhulu bayo¹
- Kuma kwemacashata esikhunjeni sayo¹

Wrong responses:

These features were based on character yet the question required physical features.

(b) Nika timbili tindlela tihlahla letilusito ngayo emphilweni yengwe.

This question was well done as most candidates were able to give ways in which trees help the leopard.

Expected responses:

- Itivikela etitseni ngekubhaca ngemacembe etihlahla¹
- Tihlahla tiyingungu yekugcina kudla kwato kungadliwa nguletinye¹
- Ingwe ihlala etihlahleni¹ (kubili kwaloku)

Wrong responses:

The main weakness was that some candidates excluded the part of how trees were useful to the leopard.

(c) Chaza lamagama ngendlela lasetjentiswe ngayo kulendzaba.

This question was fairly done as an average number of candidates were able deduce the meaning of these words as used in the passage not their usual meaning.

(i) bayatitsiya [2]

Candidates who gave wrong responses either gave back the word they were supposed to give its meaning or gave words that need further explanation.

(d) Sakhiwo sengwe sentelwa kutsi itingele kalula. Sekela ngeliphuzu linye.

Candidates were expected to mention the physical characteristics which enabled the leopard to hunt with ease and explain how that feature enables it to hunt. Candidates fairly performed in this question.

Expected responses:

- Inemehlo labona ebumnyameni¹ ngalokuphindvwe kasikhombisa kunebantfu/inemehlo labona kahle ebumnyameni¹, asita ingwe ibone kahle inyamatane ngisho ikhashane¹.

Candidates that failed to name the body organ and then explain its usefulness in hunting failed to score marks. Some gave the character of a leopard instead of its body parts.

(e) Ikukhombisa kanjani kuhlakanipha ingwe? Sekela imphendvulo yakho ngeliphuzu linye.

This question was fairly done. An average number of candidates were able to give things that are done by the leopard that are a proof of being smart.

Expected responses:

- Ihlala etulu esihlahleni¹ itokhona kubona lekutingelako/itobhacela titsa tayo¹.
- Itsi ingabamba inyamatane igibele nayo etulu esihlahleni¹ khona titsa tayo tingatoyibangisa¹.

Wrong responses:

- Ingwe itingela ebusuku sekute lokutayiphazamisa.
- Ingwe lensikati ifihla emazinyane ayo emavungwini ate akhule.

(f) Umbhali utsi intfutfuko isihlava lesitawucedza tilwane temvelo. Kushoni kuphela kwetilwane kwetilwane temvelo eveni? Chaza usekele ngeliphuzu linye. [3]

This question was poorly done as most candidates did not mention what development took place, the effect of this in the lives of animals and lastly the impact of the loss of the wild animals in to the country.

Expected responses:

Uma live litfutfuka kubhidlitwa tintsaba, kuhhedlwe emahlatsi kwakhiwe imigwaco noma takhiwo temabhizinisi¹. Loku kucedza/kunciphisa indzawo yekuhlala tilwane lokwenta kube malula kutsi bantfu batitingele/ tibe sengotini yekubulawa¹. Umnotfo welive utawulimala uma sekute tilwane temvelo ngoba tivakashi angeke tiseta kutobona letilwane¹. Loku kutawehlisa umnotfo loletfwa tekuvakasha.

Wrong responses:

• Situkulwane lesitako sengeke sisatibona letilwane, angeke asaba khona emajazi lakhiwe ngetikhumba tetinyamatane.

Some candidates wrongly phased their answers to capture how wild animals benefit the economy instead of explaining how their disappearance was detrimental to the economy of the country.

Umbuto 2

(a) Ngemagama labalelwa kulangu 60-90, bhala sifinyeto ngemitsetfo

(b) lephatselene nemhlaba waMasipala.

This question was generally well answered. The candidates were required to give rules related to living in land governed by the city council. The summary points were as follows

- Umnikati wendzawo uba neliphepha /bufakazi bekutsi umhlaba wakhe nekutsi ukuphi lomhlaba
- Kufanele utfole imvume yekumisa sakhiwo ngekuba nemdvwebo lophasiswe nguMasipala
- Uyawubhadalela umhlaba waMasipala njalo ngemnyaka
- Uyakulahlekela umhlaba uma ukweleda Masipala
- Masipala uyatihlola takhiwo tebantfu naleto temabhizinisi
- Awufuyi imfuyo lengakavumeleki edolobheni
- Indzawo yakho kufanele uyigcine ihlobile

Some candidates failed to extract the main points from the passage and included unnecessary information which did not answer the question. Some failed to differentiate between the three types of land in the passage thus they included rules that apply in a farm and on Swazi National land. Some omitted key word in the points resulting in loss of marks.

Common errors:

- Umhlaba wakho losedolobheni uyawubhadala ngenyanga instead of ngemnyaka.
- Kufanele utfole imvume and omitted the key words vesakhiwo lesiphasisiwe
- Akukavumeleki kutsi ufuye edolobheni omitting timfuyo letingakavumeleki.

Candidates were expected to write any five points from the passage and the other 5 was summary skills (language) which included the following:

- Indzima yinye
- Kubhala siSwati lesingiso
- Kusebentisa timphawu tekubhala letifanele
- Kubhala linani lemagama lelifanele

- Kubeka emaphuzu ngewakhe emagama kepha ungawushintji umcondvo aphindze alandzelane kahle.
- (c) Ungumnikati welipulazi, bomakhelwane nemfuyo kungena matsandza epulazini lakho.

 Bhalela lihhovisi lenkantolo lenkhulu ukhonone ngaloko. Incwadzi yakho ibe ngemagama labalelwa ku 120-180.

Directed writing. In this question the candidates were expected to write a letter of complaint. It was a business letter. This question was badly done. Most candidates were not specific in their complaint. They did not state the damage done by the animals and neighbors, ways they have tried to solve the problem and how they want the court to help them. Some misinterpreted a farm for a plot.

Candidates must proof read their work as a lot of grammatical mistakes result in loss of marks.

In this section candidates were expected to display their grammatical knowledge. They were to identify, form and segment parts of speech. They were also to use them in constructing sentences. Candidates performed below average in this section, with some scoring zero.

It was noted that most candidates in this question failed mainly because they ignored the other parts of the question thus failed to identify the specific word required by the question and gave any word that is that part of speech. For example:

- They gave /libala/ for class 6 noun because they ignored the class
- They gave /tona / for sabito lesibalako because they ignored lesibalako

(b) Chaza ingucuko leyenteke uma kwakhiwa lamagama.

Candidates were required to give the change that took place when deriving the words. It was important for the candidates to give the initial word from which these words were derived, in order to state the change. Moreover, the position of the sound that changed was key in this question.

Candidates were expected to explain the formation of the underlined word Lomakhosi. Candidates were expected to state the word it was derived from, the formation morpheme used and its position and the changes that took place in the affixation of the formative morpheme.

Candidates failed to identify the word from which the proper noun had been formed. Others failed to give the correct terminology for the word processes

This question required candidates to describe the underlined morphemes. Some candidates described the whole word not the part underlined. In addition, some failed to give a full description of the morphemes thus obtained less marks.

Literature and Culture

Key Messages

Candidates should analyze the questions before attempting to answer to ensure that they are able to give accurate responses.

On passage-based questions candidates need to be equipped with adequate knowledge of the text so as to effectively recognize and identify the required content.

When giving evidence from the text to support their claims, candidates should go beyond merely giving direct quotes from the text by explaining or paraphrasing them.

It is key for candidates to pair their demonstration of deep knowledge of the text with a considerably structured response.

It is fundamental for candidates to be armed with adequate understanding of literary terms, devices as well as poetic jargon.

Candidates should differentiate between questions that require a general claim from those that need evidence from the poem to display detailed intended meanings.

Critically analyzing characters as they are portrayed in the text is an important aspect of literature.

General Comments

Most candidates showed little or no knowledge of literature texts studied as some chose not to attempt questions at all and amongst those who attempted there were those who displayed gross lack of content. In addition, expressing complex ideas coherently proved to be a difficult task for the candidates as they struggled to develop analytical responses. In the poetry questions the learners were hindered by lack of knowledge of poetic devices required as well as the way to present them when giving their responses. Furthermore, they really had a shortcoming when it came to the questions which required them to explain selected lines from the poem as their answers failed to give wholesome interpretations. In prose questions, it is observable that candidates have a tendency of simply retelling the story instead of giving details which answer the given question also some totally digress by creating their own plots and characters. It became apparent that some learners expected questions from the drama text "Kubindza Akunakuthula", so they used details from that text in their answers which made their responses totally irrelevant. On a positive note, candidates who scored high marks were those who gave developed and comprehensive responses which were relevant to the questions.

Comments on Specific Questions

Sicephu A: Tincwadzi letifundziwe

General comment

This was a compulsory question. The candidates' performance on this question was poor. This question was underperformed, candidates left too many blank spaces, some lack of understanding of the theme, which greatly disadvantaged them. Some showed that they never attempted it in class, however, they were expected to at least apply their poetic analysis skills learnt in class.

General comments

In this question candidates were expected to extract the poetic device *Luchumano* from stanza 2, give the type, then state the function of the poetic device in question. Most candidates failed to identify the correct poetic device and follow the instruction of where to extract the poetic device, they extracted it from any stanza.

Most candidates did not have the knowledge of the text. They could recall the name of the chief and the events leading to court case highlighted in the extract. In the last part of the question, they failed to evaluate the question wholistically. Some candidates simply repeated the same points instead of rebutting. Their ignorance of the "kuhlehla" custom had an adverse effect on their response. A remarkable number of candidates manipulated the extract and fabricated their own stories. These candidates dismally failed this question since their responses were not relevant to the question.

This question required a candidate to: recall the name of the chief, explain the events that led to the court case highlighted in the extract, describe the character of the chief, give a lesson obtained from the chief's conviction in the court and evaluate Zuke's decision of taking the matter to court. This means that, in the last part, the candidates had to come up with responses that support the claim (2) and support them with textual evidence. Then move on to counter the aforementioned claims with 2 more claims before taking a stand which was based on what the candidate had discussed (not any new point).

This question was compulsory. It was an essay question and candidates' performance on this question was good. It demonstrated that most candidates were well versed on the novel. Excellent responses dealt with all aspects of the question, analyzing the points, and linking with relevant textual examples. Weaker responses only gave a list of examples of Zebedewu's cunning character. Some did not support their answers, were general without giving clear textual examples. Some candidates were narrating the novel and mixing up characters. Some candidates kept repeating the same examples for different points. A few candidates wrote about "Kubindza Akunakuthula."
