PART 3: PRACTICAL WRITING

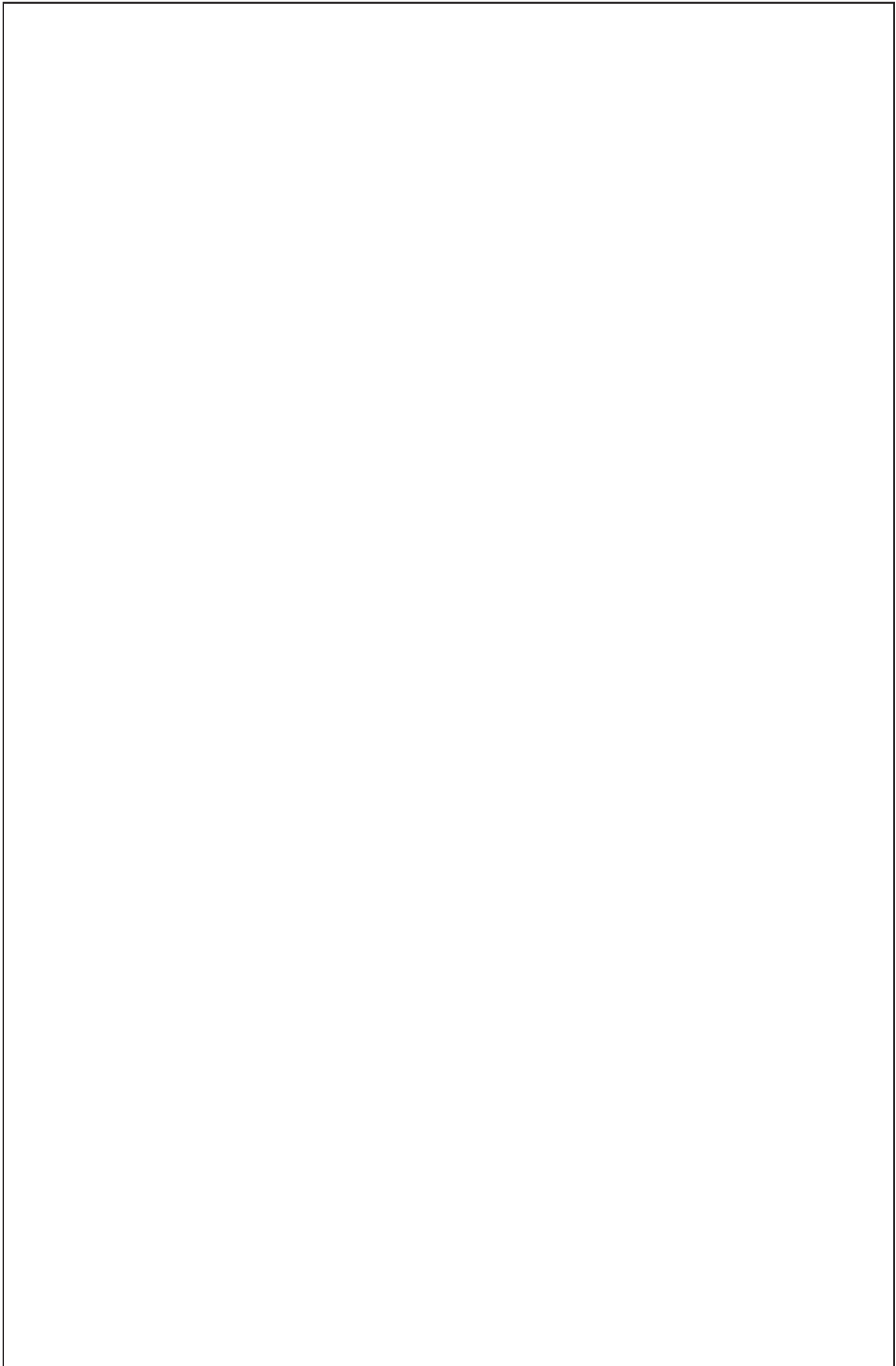
You are advised to spend about 20 minutes on this part of the paper.
